SEMMA REPRESENTS AT PARLIAMENTARY HEARING: Joint Standing Committee on Migration

MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA - SEMMA is set to represent at the public hearing for the Parliamentary Joint Standing Committee on Migration today. The hearing is part of the committee's Migration, Pathway to Nation Building inquiry and will take place at the Stamford Plaza Melbourne Hotel.

SEMMA's appearance is scheduled for this afternoon and will be presented by President Peter Angelico, also the founder of ABECK Group in Dandenong South. Representing the manufacturing industry's interests on migration is critical to ensure that the industry can continue to thrive and grow. As the industry grows, so too does the need for skilled workers, and ensuring that a streamlined migration process is in place is essential.

By representing the industry's interests, SEMMA is advocating for policies that will enable manufacturers to access the talent they need to remain competitive in a global market. This in turn supports the industry, contributing to job creation, economic growth, and the continued prosperity of the region. Our submission efforts highlight the importance of collaboration between industry and government to ensure that policies support the needs of the manufacturing sector.

The hearing format will be similar to other parliamentary inquiry hearings, with individual witnesses and organisations each appearing for 40 minutes. Witnesses will have the opportunity to make a brief opening statement.
